- Invoices and work orders must have the BC Safety Authority registration number, make and model number of qualifying natural gas heating unit, and date of installation.
- Pacific Northern Gas offer valid only for purchases and installations completed between October 17, 2005 and December 31, 2006.
- Warranties offered by manufacturers may have some restrictions. Please contact the dealer for more information.
- Manufacturer's administer their own offers.
- To be eligible for the rebate, the customer must return a copy of the invoice or work order which contains the date of installation and details of all work performed along with the proper Pacific Northern Gas completed form.

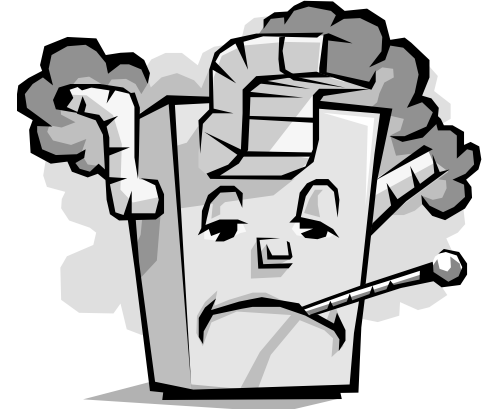

PNG Gas bill credit— Upgrade your old natural gas furnace or boiler with an ENERGY STAR qualified high-efficiency natural gas heating system between October 17, 2005 and December 31, 2006 and receive a \$250 credit on your PNG Gas bill.

Variable speed motor— Receive an extra \$100 PNG Gas bill credit if you purchase an ENERGY STAR qualified natural gas furnace with a variable speed motor between October 17, 2005 and December 31, 2006.

No provincial sales tax — ENERGY STAR qualified high-efficiency natural gas heating system including furnaces and boilers, are exempt from provincial sales tax. This means you'll save an added seven per cent on the purchase price of new home heating equipment. Ask your gas contractor for more information.

Is it time for retirement?



If your furnace is more than 10 years old, it's likely a low-efficiency model, only averaging between 60 and 70 per cent AFUE (Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency). In other words, it's only producing around 60 to 70 cents worth of heat for every dollar you spend. Install an ENERGY STAR qualified high-efficiency natural gas furnace or boiler and your heating system will run at a minimum of 90 per cent or 85 per cent AFUE respectively. ENERGY STAR qualified furnaces with high efficiency variable speed motors can greatly reduce your furnace's electrical consumption. If you purchase a furnace with a variable speed motor, there's no need to fill out any additional forms as the furnace's model number will indicate whether it qualifies for the additional bill credit.
