Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. Transmission Pipeline Emergency Exercise

On March 14, 2019, Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. and the Thornhill Fire Department are conducting an emergency training exercise in coordination with other partner organizations. No significant disruptions to residents or the public are anticipated.

The exercise is important for safety purposes to practice the emergency response procedures for a natural gas incident.

The following may be visible at, or around, the intersections of BC Hwy 16 and Thornhill Frontage Road, Wade Road and Haaland Ave:

- Utility vehicles, fire trucks, and emergency response personnel coordinating and staging activities;
- Signs indicating an emergency training exercise is in progress.
